Progress of UNIHEAL+

PR1 UNIHEAL+ Framework Courses – a completed approach has already completed its first part, research. Desk research has addressed the emerging need for the digital reskilling and upskilling of the health professionals across the EU in general and in the researched countries, that is: Cyprus, Greece, Lithuania, Romania, and Spain. The consortium engaged 196 participants in total; 167 completed the survey and 29 participated in the focus groups, conducted in each partner country. All partners have been involved in the design of the 6 competence units proposed:

CU1: Framework skills and aptitudes for digital communication

CU2: Computer literacy, data analysis, data protection programs

CU3: eHealth & mHealth context and content

CU4: Medical devices and their use in clinical practice

CU5: Mobile applications, cloud storage, internet usability-functionality

CU6: Universal digital health coverage

TARGET GROUPS ADDRESSED:

-The frontline health sectorstaff/professionals (e.g.nurses, doctors, pharmacists, physicians, dentists, midwives, etc.)

-The VET educators who undertake the role and tasks of effectively addressing the training of health professionals

PR2 - *The Adaptation and Training Guide for UNIHEAL+ Educators* — aims at offering context and support to the VET educators, through specific guidelines on how to integrate the training package and the whole material, derived from the UNIHEAL project development into the training handbook.

The PR2 consists of 2 parts. The 1st is addressed the activities of the project, developed throughout the development of PR1: the theoretical framework, the curriculum presentations and the media sources, while the 2nd part mentions the exemplary scenarios and lesson plans which enrich the content and permits the user to obtain further knowledge on the current digital health patterns in adult learning. Soon, the handbook will be available in *Spanish*, *Lithuanian*, *Greek*, *Romanian*, *and English* versions.
